Technical support levels have been violated in spot month crude oil thanks to plunging global equity markets. The Dow Jones Industrials average closed 831 points lower yesterday and futures trade points to another 300 point drop on the opening if trade continues to hover near early trade today. This stoked demand fears and sparked panic selling in the regular energy complex that violated last week's low. That negated the early week reversal higher and will paint a bearish technical picture if spot month crude oil suffers another sharply lower close today. The recent uptrend had already been building up some obstacles as some OPEC+ producers have increased production and cuts in global economic growth forecasts had cast a shadow over demand ideas. In addition US supply and demand data released yesterday from private industry sources showed a 2nd straight week of large crude supply increases. API data released during the onslaught of the equity market collapse showed crude stocks had risen 9.7 mb. If today's Dept of Energy data is similar additional selling pressure may emerge. Energy market will likely take their que from equity market action today until that market stabilizes. Technical downside targets for spot month crude may now become moving average levels just below \$ 70.00.






